WORLD DOCTORS ORCHESTRA

The World Doctors Orchestra (WDO) combines the joy of great music with global medical responsibility. Founded in 2008, the orchestra has grown from 60 participants from 12 countries in the first session to more than 1,800 doctors from 60 countries. By 2023, WDO has performed 40 concert sessions all over the world, raising nearly 2 million Euros in donations for medical charity.

Four times a year, around 100 physicians from numerous countries meet for several days of intensive rehearsals to then exchange their white coats for evening attire and perform charity concerts. The proceeds from each concert session go to selected medical aid organizations. In addition to the direct financial contribution, the organizations benefit substantially from the international solidarity and media attention associated with WDO concerts.

The WDO is set up as an independent non-profit association driven by the spirit of the orchestra members. The participants cover their own travel expenses as well as donating towards the session expenses, while local costs are kept as low as possible. Although all of the physicians share a passion for music, the driving force behind WDO is the conviction that neither national borders nor political or economic interests should limit access to adequate healthcare. With its series of charity concerts, WDO strives to raise global awareness that healthcare is a basic human right and a precondition for human development.

The WDO made its debut in May 2008 with an inaugural concert in the Berlin Philharmonie. In June 2018, WDO celebrated its 10 year anniversary and 25th concert session

with phenomenal concerts at the Elbphilharmonie Hamburg and the Berlin Philharmonie, and in 2023, we celebrated the 15 year anniversary. The commitment of our participants, friends, and supporters has led to WDO becoming the leading international doctors' orchestra. In addition, WDO members have performed in smaller chamber music groups and have founded several national and regional doctors' orchestras, thereby enhancing our global impact.


In 15 years, WDO has given 71 concerts together with many famous soloists (see next pages) and in addition several pre-concerts at hospitals for patients and healthcare workers. Many more people can enjoy WDO concerts on our digital music channel and with live streams.

The excellent musical skills of our participants have allowed WDO to perform many of the most challenging romantic and modern classical masterworks. Furthermore, our broad repertoire has included around 80 composers from baroque to contemporary times, several newly commissioned pieces for WDO, and crossover music.

The World Doctors Orchestra has developed into an eminent non-professional orchestra and is proud to serve as a global medical ambassador. We look forward to further exciting sessions around the world with great concerts, enthusiastic audiences, and important support of medical charities.





STEFAN WILLICH MUSIC DIRECTOR

Stefan Willich is the founder and conductor of the World Doctors Orchestra. He studied violin, chamber music, and conducting in Stuttgart and Berlin, and has participated in prestigious conducting workshops with Sergiu Celibidache (Munich), Leon Fleisher (Boston, Tanglewood) and Leon Barzin (Paris). Besides his performances with WDO, he regularly appears as guest conductor mainly in Germany and the USA where he is the principal guest conductor of the CityMusic Cleveland Orchestra.

His professional path, however, first led him into medicine, where he became a highly regarded internist and epidemiologist, focusing on cardiovascular disease, prevention, health economics, integrative medicine, and arts and medicine. For several years he worked at Harvard University in Boston, and in 1995 was appointed Professor and Director of the Institute of Social Medicine, Epidemiology and Health Economics at the Charité – Universitätsmedizin Berlin, a post he continues to hold to this day. From 2012 to 2014, Stefan Willich was President of the Hanns Eisler School of Music Berlin. In 2021, he received the Alumni Award of Merit from the Harvard University T.H. Chan School of Public Health, the highest award for former graduates of the institution.
